Infants and children with a feeding disorder fail to grow adequately, or even lose weight. This requires a multidisciplinary team approach to assess the child's needs and to develop a management plan. The Importance of a Multifaceted Approach in the Assessment and Management of Feeding Disorders. Whilst it discusses organic causes of failure to thrive, the management of each disorder is individual. The term became established in the early 20th Century, meaning when growth in infants and children was poor. A multi-disciplinary team approach is required.
